Passing along the blessing

...to Ethiopia

"Dear Alynne, we have a **10 yr old child in Ethiopia with HIV** and they are asking me to **test all 60 children** when I go. I am leaving on Sept. 16th. Would you be able to send me them before my leaving date? Elaine"

We shipped 90 HIV tests in time for Elaine's trip.

"Thank you Alynne for this quick shipment. He is on ARV's [antiretroviral therapy] and doing well, he is our second child with HIV, we have one in Malawi also and he is a teenager and doing well. HIV has entered a phase of being classified as a chronic illness if they are well treated with ARV's and we know God has a reason for these two boys being positive. The teen in Malawi came from an Islamic background and he is a true orphan and now an amazing Christian young man. We do pray they will be able to handle this infection."

We covered the full cost of the diagnostics and shipping.

"Dear Alynne, thank you for this gift to Rafiki! You have been and are a blessing to us and to many and honor and glorify the Lord with your service. I am **sending a gift anyway because I want you to be able to bless others** and us in the coming years."

Yes, you read the correctly. A woman, who received her tests for free, turned around and sent us money so we could assist others who need our diagnostics.

...to Madagascar

Last Easter I had several folks over for lunch (more than half of whom I had never met before). One of those people (a high

school French teacher) learned about Science with a Mission and later mailed me a check for use for **diagnostics for a French-speaking country in Africa**. With that money, I was able to cover the full cost of diagnostics for the Sarobidy Maternity Center in Madagascar.
